- 悉尼

 悉尼歌剧院(外观) 20世纪最具特色的建筑之一,也是世界著名的表演艺术中心,已成为悉尼市的标志性建筑。
- 玫瑰湾 也称情人湾。海湾周围都是豪宅,停泊着许多游艇和帆船,还有私人海上飞机, 是悉尼最有名望的的富人区。
- 悉尼海鲜市场-南半球最大的海鲜市场,零售、批发鱼货上百种,还有售卖热面包、寿司、 龙虾沙律、炸鱼虾、墨鱼卷等各类海鲜的熟食店等您来品尝。
- 达令港 -又叫"情人港",是悉尼居民和游客最爱游览的地方之一,也是一处休闲及购物的好地方。
- 库克船游船-世界上没有第二个海港可以与悉尼港的美丽与惊艳相媲美,游船观光是游览这座海港的最佳方式。您可以享用美食,搭配全世界最美丽的海港景色,绝对是超出想象的浪漫之旅。
- 蓝山公园 2000年被列入自然类世界遗产,全地区生长着庞大的原始森林和亚热 雨林。 在蓝山中心景点卡顿巴(Katoomba),可乘坐3种缆车游览丛林景色(世界上最陡的观光火车+空中缆车+横向缆车),也可以在回声台(Echo Point)领略三姐妹峰的秀美英姿。
- **萝拉-**花园小镇 -罗拉小镇在悉尼蓝山下,很梦幻的山中小镇。那里有历史悠久的建筑物和优美的花园,独栋的小屋,尖尖的屋顶,小而精致的花园,以森林为后院,绿草为前庭,是一个非常美丽、宁静、充满生活气息的小镇。小镇里绿草如茵,鲜花盛放,处处都洋溢着诗意,让人仿佛置身在童话的浪漫国度。

墨尔本

- 战争纪念碑 -为了纪念11万4千多名参加第一次世界大战的维多利亚州士兵,其中1万9千名 在欧洲战场上牺牲的士兵而建造的。
- **圣珀德里克教堂** -是墨尔本也是南半球最大最高的天主教堂。这座哥特式建筑风格的大教堂,大部分用青石建成,由著名英籍建筑师华岱负责设计。
- 维多利亚王后市场 -墨尔本市内最大的,历史最悠久的跳蚤市场(摊位市场)。在这里有1000多家摊位,分别销售蔬菜水果,海鲜肉类,服装玩具,小五金和澳洲当地特产等。(逢周一,周三和公共假期休息)
- 佛兹罗公园 公园里绿树葱葱,鸟语花香,带着浓厚的英国乡村浪漫色彩。园内林木青葱,举凡花圃、温室、喷泉、小湖、步道、雕像等规划优美,还有一棵树龄高达 130 年的古木,成为最热门的婚纱猎镜地点。
- 丹迪浓森林保护区(含SKYHIGH展望台) -公园占地3215公顷,对保护著名的琴鸟、其他动物和林中和山脉上的蕨类植物起到了重要的作用。SKYHIGH展望台可以看墨尔本本的全景。
- **树熊自然保护区** 致力于保护考拉的可持续生态和生存环境,游客可以一边漫步在澳大利亚丛林中,一边在考拉的自然栖息地中观赏野生考拉。
- 小企鹅自然生态保护区 菲利普岛的企鹅是世界上最小的企鹅,身高仅30公分,每当日落时分,便可见到可爱企鹅们成群大摇大摆的从海上陆续归巢,由于它们体型娇小,排列在一起摇摇摆摆地走,甚是有趣。(普通区平台)
- 大洋路 是澳洲维多利亚省的一条行车公路,全长约276公里,建于悬崖峭壁中间。大洋路于1920年为了纪念第一次世界大战中牺牲的人而建的。大洋路可看到最著名的景色莫过于"十二使徒岩"(The Twelve Apostles),它们是海边一组十二块各自独立的岩石,其数量及形态恰巧酷似耶稣的十二使徒,因此就以圣经故事里的这"十二门徒"命名之。

SYDNEY

- Sydney Opera House A must-visit iconic landmark of Australia that recognized by UNESCO as a Cultural Heritage. Some say, never been Great Wall, means you never been China; well Sydney say, never been the Sydney Opera House, meaning you never been Australia.

- Sydney Fish Market Incorporates a working fishing port, wholesale fish market, fresh seafood retail market, a delicatessen, a sushi bar, a bakery, a gift shop, a fruit and vegetable market ,a florist, a beverage outlet, a seafood cooking school, indoor seating and an outdoor promenade for visitors.
- **Darling Harbour –** Sydney favourite destination for leisure and entertainment, with more than 40 restaurants, 30 bars, cafes, museums, theatres, parks and more,
- Blue Mountain Another UNESCO recognized natural heritage attraction in Sydney. Natural view and beautiful scenery that could give you lot of nostalgia. At Echo Point, you can capture beautiful scenery of Three Sister Rocks. Scenic World with 3 rides (Railway + Cableway + Skyway) make your iourney easier and fun.
- Leura is now as popular for visitors to the Blue Mountains. The area boasts many gardens which are privately owned yet open at selected times of the year to the public. The natural wonders of Leura can be discovered via the many walks.

- Queen Victoria Market Is more than just Melbourne's shopping mecca it is a historic landmark, a tourist attraction and an institution for visitors. (Closed on Mon, Wed & Public Holidays)
- MT Dandenong with SKY HIGH observation desk exploring the freshen air forest and experience Mt Dandenong's Sky High with the most incredible Melbourne city skyline views
- Koala Conservation Centre Admission Stroll through this eucalypt woodland and come face-to-face' with koalas in their natural habitat. The Koala Conservation Centre's unique tree top boardwalks and close viewing areas allow visitors to see how truly amazing koalas are.
- Penguin Parade Ever watched Happy Feet? If you didn't, well, now you are giving a chance to meet these cute little penguins shuffling in front of your eyes in the sunset! Meanwhile, visitors also will learn the importance of conserving natural habitat and the beauty of nature environment. (Standard View Platform)
- Great Ocean Road- Drive one of the world's most scenic coastal touring routes, the Great Ocean Road, spanning 243 kilometres along the stunning coastline of Victoria's south-west. Take in the panoramic views as the road winds along cliff tops, up to breathtaking headlands, down onto the edge of beaches, across river estuaries and through lush rainforests. This is the most famous section of the Great Ocean Road featuring an amazing collection of rock formations known as the 12 Apostles which have been carved out of the headland by the fierce waves of the southern ocean.
