## **DUBAI**

- Burj Al Arab- (Tower of the Arabs) is a luxury hotel located in Dubai, United Arab Emirates. It has been called "The world's only 7 star Hotel" and is the third tallest hotel in the world. Burj Al Arab stands on an artificial island 321m from Jumeirah beach and is connected to the mainland by a private curving bridge. The shape of the structure is designed to mimic the sail of a ship.
- The Palm Jumeirah- It is one of three planned islands called the Palm Islands (Palm Jumeirah, Palm Jebel Ali and Palm Deira) which would have extended into the Persian Gulf, increasing Dubai's shoreline by a total of 520 kilometres (320 mi). The Palm Jumeirah is the smallest and the original of three Palm Islands originally under development by Nakheel. It is located on the Jumeirah coastal area of the emirate of Dubai, in the United Arab Emirates.
- New Marina- is a modern shopping and lifestyle destination for residents and visitors. With more than 130 outlets and a gross leasable area of 390,000 sq ft spread across four levels, Dubai Marina Mall features a retail mix of high street fashion brands, aspirational boutique fashion, al fresco waterfront dining, a supermarket and a good entertainment offer.
- Burj Khalifa-Formerly known as Burj Dubai is located in Dubai, United Arab Emirates territory of skyscrapers is currently the world's tallest man-made structures with a height of 828 m, total 169 floors, cost up to \$ 1.5 billion.
- Dubai Creek- is a saltwater creek located in Dubai, United Arab Emirates (UAE).
   The creek divided the city into two main sections Deira and Bur Dubai. In the early 20th century, the creek though incapable then of supporting large scale transportation, served as a minor port for dhows coming as far away as India or East
- Dhow Dinner Cruise- A Dhow Cruise with a different scenery! A Cruise on board
  the traditional Arabian Dhow in the heart of 'New Dubai'. The Dubai Marina is a canal
  city in the Venetian tradition, carved along a two mile stretch of Persian Gulf
  shoreline.
- Spice Souk and Gold Souk- is a traditional market in Dubai. Stores in the Spice
  Souk sell a variety of fragrances and spices from frankincense and shisha to the
  many herbs used in Arabic and South Asian food. In addition, several household,
  textiles, incense, rugs and artifacts are also sold in the Spice Souk. Gold souk
  consists of over 300 retailers that trade almost exclusively in jewellery. Retailers in
  the souk include both well-established stores like Damas, ARY Jewellery, Shyam
  Jewellery and Joyalukkas.
- Souq Al Bahar- is an Arabesque shopping, entertainment and dining destination located in the heart of Downtown Dubai. Its over 100 shops include 22 restaurants, cafés and lounges, mostly located along the souks extensive waterfront promenade overlooking the majestic Dubai Fountain and the world's tallest building -Burj Khalifa.
