## KAMAKURA

- **Kamakura Daibutsu** – Built in 1252, is a bronze statue of Amida Buddha, which stands on the grounds of Kotokuin Temple. With a height of 13.35 meters, it is the second tallest bronze Buddha statue in Japan. However, the temple buildings was destroyed by tsunami in the 15th century. After that the Buddha has been standing in the open air.

## HAKONE

- **Lake Ashi (Ashi-no-ko)** – Was formed in the caldera of Mount Hakone after the volcano's last eruption 3000 years ago. And the boat ride could enjoy dreams and romance while gazing upon the delights of Mt. Fuji.
- **Gotemba Premium Outlets** – 210 Outlet stores .Gotemba Premium Outlets® is the flagship center, and one of the largest centers in Japan. It is situated on an extensive site within view of World Cultural Heritage site, Mt. Fuji.
- **Peace Park** – The stupa, the symbol of the park, keeps the Buddha's ashes presented by late Indian Prime Minister Nehru. 4 golden images of Buddha are also housed.
- **Owakudani** – Owakudani boiling volcano valley, a volcanic valley where sulphurous fumes rise from crevices in the rocks. (subject to operating condition)

## MOUNT FUJI

- **Mount Fuji** – Mt. Fuji, rising above the clouds, is the symbol of Japan and has provided a spiritual basis for the Japanese since ancient times. This 3776 meters high, dormant volcano is world renowned for its symmetry and serenity.
- **Oshino Hakkai** – Is underground water from Mt. Fuji. It begins with the snow on the top of Mt. Fuji. The water travel over 80 years, and finally spring at Oshino Hakkai.

## TOKYO

- **Asakusa Kannon Temple** – The temple is dedicated to the god of mercy, Kannon. And is famous for its Kaminari-mon or Thunder Gate. And you could walk along
- **Imperial Palace** – formerly the Tokugawa family's residence, was opened in the Meiji Restoration and later re-named as the Imperial Palace, and it's famous for the Nijubashi Bridge in front of the main entrance.
- **Ginza District** – Is Tokyo's most famous up market shopping, featuring numerous department stores, boutiques, art galleries, restaurants and cafes. Also one of the most expensive, upscale areas in Tokyo which is jewelled with upscale retail like as Louis Vutton, Chanel, Hermes, De Beers, Tiffany and Apple.
- **Shinjuku Karatetsu Street** – Combination of shopping, entertainment & red-light district..
- **Odaiba Rainbow Bridge** – links the futuristic leisure town of Odaiba with the Tokyo Waterfront, crossing Tokyo Bay underneath. Named after the beautiful rainbow coloured lighting that graces the structure in the evenings, the bridge is one of the city's most popular and attractive landmarks.
- **DiverCity Tokyo Plaza** – Three large-scale entertainment facilities in DiverCity Tokyo Plaza, including one that launches for the very first time in the world. The world's first permanent Gundam entertainment facility, Gundam Front Tokyo provides a full experience.
