- **沙田车公庙** - 原本是一座已有300年历史的庙宇，侯于1994年改建成目前的模样。当年，村民相信车公能保佑他们免受洪水瘟疫之患，所以就盖了这座庙。相传，车公是宋朝（公元960至1279年）一位大元帅，曾平定华南一场叛乱。南宋末年，宋帝昀南下避难，车大元帅一直护驾到香港，並驻守西貢。後來获道教奉为神明，並立庙供奉。
- **太平山** - 站在海拔373米的太平山顶上，您就像是乘坐飞机横越维多利亚港的上空，超过300万居民的香港市区—维港两岸的九龙半岛、香港岛北岸，将一一展现在您的眼前。就这样，一幢幢摩天大楼笔直的耸立着，看似伸手可及。别忘了，香港是全球人口密度最高的城市之一。想象一下，当山下无数座大楼都同时亮起灯时，维港的海面、维港的上空都被映照得发紫，那会是多么壮丽璀璨。
- **船游维多利亚港** - 爱维港的人，或许也会爱上天星小轮，因为乘小轮漫游维港，可以真正感受维港的美。美国的《国家地理旅游杂志》就曾将搭乘天星小轮游览维港，列为“人生50个必游项目”之一。自1888年起，天星小轮已开始接载香港市民穿梭维港，即使现在已有多条海底隧道及地铁贯通维港，每天仍有很多市民选择搭乘天星小轮。
- **大埔林村** - 早在700多年前的宋朝末年，就已经有乡人聚居。村里的许愿树和天后庙是本地人与游客祈福许愿的胜地，在农历新年时尤其热闹。
- **香港摩天轮** - 中环新地标。高60公尺的香港摩天轮，您可以自费乘坐摩天轮從一個崭新的角度欣赏维港的日與夜。香港摩天轮有42个车厢（包括一个VIP车厢），每个车厢可载八名乘客，繞行一圈要花15至20分鐘。車廂內有恆溫設備，不論是夏天還是冬天乘坐，都沒有問題。而且車廂內的免費Wi-Fi功能，讓您可以輕鬆打卡、即時跟朋友分享喜悅。摩天輪附近有一個活動廣場，提供小吃

- **观音像** - 观音像高20米，整个莲花座高7米，直径为19米，由重50吨青铜制成。

HONG KONG

- **Shatin Che Kung Temple** - This temple located in the Tai Wai area of Sha Tin honours Che Kung, a military commander of the Southern Song dynasty (1127-1279) whose advantageous power for suppressing uprisings and plagues made him a household name. In popular folklore, it's said that Che Kung escorted the Song dynasty's last emperor on his escape to Sai Kung in what is now called the New Territories. His achievements led to him eventually becoming revered as a god.
- **Victoria Peak** - The highest point on Hong Kong Island, this has been the city's most exclusive neighbourhood since colonial times. That view is also what makes The Peak one of the most popular attractions in Hong Kong. By day your eyes stretch across sparkling skyscrapers and Victoria Harbour all the way to the green hills of the New Territories.
- **Victoria Harbour Night View Sightseeing** - Even locals can't get enough of Hong Kong's magnificent skyline at dusk. It looks incredibly serene as it's cast in hues of orange and pink, yet continues to bubble with action like recently popped champagne. This wonderful panorama is best experienced from the water on board a Hong Kong evening harbour cruise.
- **Tai Po Lam Tsuen Wishing Trees** - Was already a residential area 700 years ago during the Southern Song dynasty (1127-1279). Today, it still bustles with people and visitors thanks to its two 'wishing trees' and Tin Hau Temple. In the past, whenever there was a festival, villagers would throw joss paper into two trees and make wishes. They believed that the higher the branch the joss paper landed on, the more likely it was the wish would come true.
- **Hongkong Observation Wheel** - Get stunning day- and night-time views of the spectacular Victoria Harbour on the 60-metre-high Hong Kong Observation Wheel. The wheel has 42 luxurious gondolas (including one VIP gondola) that comfortably seat eight passengers and come equipped with high-speed Wi-Fi. The area around the wheel includes a plaza for events as well as drinks and snacks and free Wi-Fi.

MACAU

- **Studio City** - A monumental new world of glamor and excitement is about to be unveiled. Studio City brings you the very best in global entertainment, iconic landmarks and resort experiences that can't be found anywhere else on earth. - **Ruins of St.Paul** - Ruins of St. Paul's in Macau are marvelous sample of the Catholic history of this former Portuguese colony.
- **A-Ma Temple** - Is dedicated to the god A-Ma (Mother and Queen of the Sea) whom Macau is named after. And consists of Ming dynasty shrines, prayer halls, pavilions and gardens creeping up the hillside.
- **Statue of Kun Lam** - The bronze Kun Lam Statue, measuring 20 metres in height, and the dome-shaped lotus base, which is 7 metres high, 19 metres in diameter and is composed of sixteen petals.
